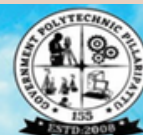

DR B.R. AMBEDKAR BIRTH ANNIVERSARY

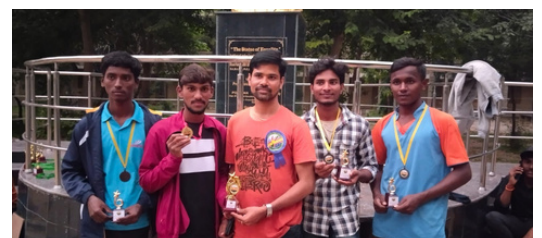

To ensure safe and clean drinking water for Staff and Students, RO water purifier along with Water cooler was installed.



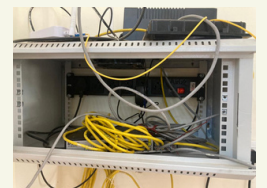
